



The Kentucky Technology Student Association announces the availability of the Kentucky Technology Student Association Distinguished Leaders Scholarship in the amount of \$250.00 for an undergraduate student majoring in either teacher preparation – with certification in Technology Education or a technical or engineering field of study. The scholarship has been created in honor of several distinguished leaders of Kentucky TSA who have made significant contributions to the growth, development, and success of the organization. Those leaders are Tom Osborne, Larry Downs, Bobby Woods, Eugene Keith, and Henry Lacy. The award is based upon evidence of leadership potential, the desire to teach Technology Education or to enter a technical or engineering career.

### **Number and Nature of Scholarship**

A maximum of 2 scholarships in the amount of \$250.00 will be awarded. The scholarship shall be for one academic year and used to defray costs of the student's college and academic expenses.

### **Eligibility**

Applicant shall be:

1. A resident of Kentucky
2. A graduating senior with a minimum 3.0 GPA and accepted into a baccalaureate, associate, or certificate granting institution.
3. A current member of an affiliated Chapter of TSA in good standing.
4. A current or former local TSA officer with a minimum of 1 term of office.
5. A TSA member that has attended a minimum of 1 state or national conference.
6. A TSA member that has placed in the top 3 in any competitive events at the state conference or a finalist in any competitive event at the national conference.
7. A student who wishes to become a technology education teacher or enter a technology-related career.

### **Application and Deadlines**

Applicants must complete in full detail the Kentucky Technology Student Association distinguished leader Scholarship Application Form along with supporting documentation as specified. Application deadline is a postmark of February 19th each year.

The scholarship will be awarded at the Kentucky Technology Student Association state conference and the recipient will be notified at least two weeks prior to the state event.

**Selection of Recipients**

An impartial selection committee composed of education professionals selects the recipients after the submission deadline. In evaluating the applications, the committee will ensure applications meet all eligibility requirements. The required essays are an important part of the evidence to be considered.
